

Gentle Ben is one of 33 stray and abandoned cats that were rescued from the north side of Syracuse. He was living outside for many years, seen walking down the street slowly with his head down, appearing to have given up. His nickname was Rocky due to his beaten down appearance and his disfigured ears. He was finally rescued by a Cat Coalition volunteer, treated for his medical issues, neutered, and vaccinated. At first he would only lay on the bare floor, ignoring the soft blankets and comfy beds offered to him. 


