

In late December, we were contacted by someone about a cat outside who was limping badly and clearly in a lot of pain. A neighbor later reported that she had seen a cat thrown out of a car window by someone driving down the street. He was cold and hungry but still believed humans were good and were there to help him.

Thankfully, one of our volunteer foster parents responded and took Reggie into her home. Even in that much pain, Reggie was such a sweet boy and was so thankful to be saved. Our volunteer took him to the vet right away and an x-ray showed that he had a fracture of the tibia and fibula on his left

hind leg as well as a fracture to the pubic bone. Because of the extent of damage to the bones, the only viable option was to amputate his rear left leg. Thankfully, Reggie was able to get surgery in January and after a few weeks, he was happily getting around as a tripod cat! Cats are amazingly adaptable and we've seen so many cats lose a leg and bounce right back.

Reggie's vet care cost more than \$1,500, which is well under what it could have cost, thanks to the generous discounts of our vet partners. We put out the call on our Facebook page asking our supporters to help with these steep costs and you helped us raise nearly \$1,400! We're so thankful that we have animal lovers like you to count on when cats like Reggie need your generosity.

Reggie was adopted in late February to his forever home and he is doing great! His new mom named him Rickety Cricket and is so excited to give him a loving family.
